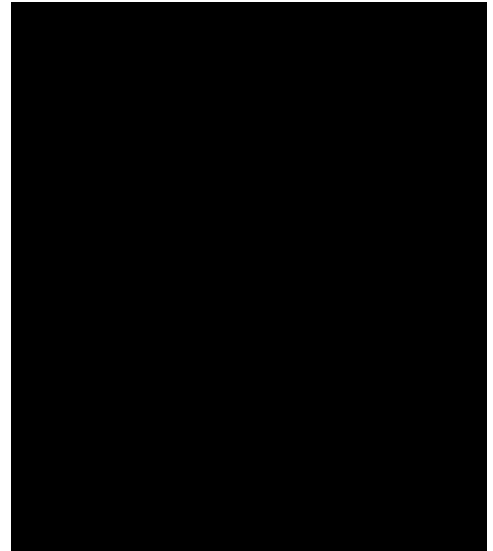

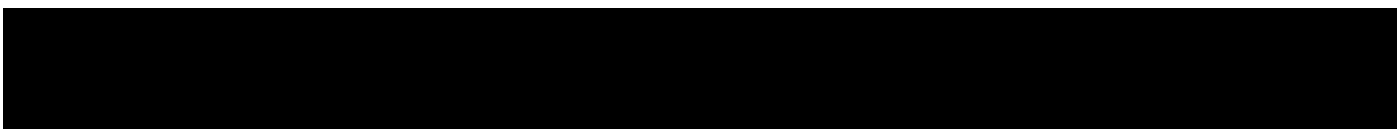

**CORPORATE ACCOUNTABILITY PROJECT - REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO INFORMATION**

**SECTION 57(2) EXTENSION OF PERIOD TO DEAL WITH REQUEST**

- 1 We act for Pick 'n Pay Retailers (Pty) Ltd ("**our client**"). Our client has handed us your letter of 16 November 2022 and requested that we address you as is set out below.
- 2 Our client is in the process of compiling the information that it has in order to respond to your request.
- 3 As you are aware, your request is extensive and accordingly requires a search through a large number of records and consultation with various people within the organisation.
- 4 As envisaged by section 57 (1) (a) & (c) of the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000 ("**the Act**"), compliance with the original period would unreasonably interfere with the activities of our client. Whilst our client will endeavour to respond to your request timeously, it is reasonably unlikely that it will be in a position to do so within the original period allowed to respond to the request.
- 5 The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notice, as we hereby do, that our client has invoked the extension of the period to respond to your request provided for in section 56(2) to extend the period to respond to your request by an additional 30 days.
- 6 Accordingly, our client will respond to your request by no later than 16 January 2023.
